I am writing this booklet because of the things that I see taking place in the world. The Bible says that there will be several things that will take place in the end times. If you have read my book “Fishing”, in chapter 7, you would have read about the end times prophecies that are about to be fulfilled. The last sentence of that chapter states:

“The next prophesy that we see is for the rapture of the church and the tribulation period.”

So what is going on in the world? If you are reading this and the Rapture has occurred and you are thinking that perhaps all the “foolishness” that we had told you about was in fact the truth. Or perhaps there is a story going on about how the disappearance of the “Christians” was god’s way of ridding the earth of us so that you can enjoy life as you desire without us bothering you. Regardless of what you think, you will be facing what is coming.

What is coming you may ask. Here is what you can expect:

1. The total destruction of Damascus, Syria. This is foretold in the Bible.

There are actually two key Biblical prophecies that explain that at an unspecified time in the future, the city of Damascus will be completely destroyed — judged by God — and will not be inhabited again.

Isaiah 17:1-3 — “The oracle concerning Damascus. ‘Behold, Damascus is about to be removed from being a city and will become a fallen ruin. The cities of Aroer are forsaken; they will be for flocks to lie down in, and there will be no one to frighten them. The fortified city will disappear from Ephraim, and sovereignty from Damascus....’

Jeremiah 49:23-27 — “Concerning Damascus. ‘Hamath and Arpad are put to shame, for they have heard bad news; they are disheartened. There is anxiety by the sea, it cannot be calmed. Damascus has become helpless; she has turned away to flee, and panic has gripped her; distress and pangs have taken hold of her like a woman in childbirth. How the city of praise has not been deserted, the town of My joy! Therefore, her young men will fall in her streets, and all the men of war will be silenced in that day,’ declares the Lord of hosts. ‘I will set fire to the wall of Damascus, and it will devour the fortified towers of Ben-hadad.’”

These prophecies have not yet been fulfilled. Damascus is one of the oldest continuously inhabited cities on earth. It has been attacked, besieged, and conquered. But Damascus has never been completely destroyed and left uninhabited. Yet that is exactly what the Bible says will happen. The context of Isaiah 17 and Jeremiah 49 are a series of End Times prophecies dealing with God’s judgments on Israel’s neighbors and enemies leading up to, and through, the Tribulation.¹

This may have already happened, but if not it will soon. The Bible is not clear on the actual timing of the correlation of the Rapture and this event. So when you see this happening, be sure that the rest of the prophecies in the Bible are close at hand.

2. There will be a person that will come forward and establish a peace agreement that will bring about world peace. This person is the antichrist:

1 John 2:18 - Little children, it is the last hour; and as you have heard that the Antichrist is coming, even now many antichrists have come, by which we know that it is the last hour.

1 John 2:22 - Who is a liar but he who denies that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist who denies the Father and the Son.

1 John 4:3 - and every spirit that does not confess that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is not of God. And this is the spirit of the Antichrist, which you have heard was coming, and is now already in the world.

2 John 1:7 - For many deceivers have gone out into the world who do not confess Jesus Christ as coming in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist.

Daniel 7:24 & 25 - The ten horns are ten kings who shall arise from this kingdom. And another shall rise after them; He shall be different from the first ones, And shall subdue three kings. He shall speak pompous words against the Most High, Shall persecute the saints of the Most High, And shall intend to change times and law. Then the saints shall be given into his hand. For a time and times and half a time.

Daniel 8:23 - 25 - And in the latter time of their kingdom, When the transgressors have reached their fullness, A king shall arise, Having fierce features, Who understands sinister schemes. His power shall be mighty, but not by his own power; He shall destroy fearfully, And shall prosper and thrive; He shall destroy the mighty, and also the holy people. Through his cunning He shall cause deceit to prosper under his rule; And he shall exalt himself in his heart. He shall destroy many in their prosperity. He shall even rise against the Prince of princes; But he shall be broken without human means

Daniel 9:27 - Then he shall confirm a covenant with many for one week;
But in the middle of the week
He shall bring an end to sacrifice and offering.
And on the wing of abominations shall be one who makes desolate,
Even until the consummation, which is determined,
Is poured out on the desolate.”

Matthew 24:5 - For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and will deceive many.

Matthew 24:23 - Then if anyone says to you, 'Look, here is the Christ!' or 'There!' do not believe it.

Matthew 24:24 - false christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect.

2 Thessalonians 2:3 & 4 - Let no one deceive you by any means; for that Day will not come unless the falling away comes first, and the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition, 4 who opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God or that is worshiped, so that he sits as God in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God.

2 Thessalonians 2:8 - 10 - And then the lawless one will be revealed, whom the Lord will consume with the breath of His mouth and destroy with the brightness of His coming. The coming of the lawless one is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs, and lying wonders, and with all unrighteous deception among those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth, that they might be saved.

Revelation 13:1 - Then I stood on the sand of the sea. And I saw a beast rising up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and on his horns ten crowns, and on his heads a blasphemous name.

Revelation 17:1 - 18 - Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls came and talked with me, saying to me, "Come, I will show you the judgment of the great harlot who sits on many waters, 2 with whom the kings of the earth committed fornication, and the inhabitants of the earth were made drunk with the wine of her fornication." So he carried me away in the Spirit into the wilderness. And I saw a woman sitting on a scarlet beast which was full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns. The woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet, and adorned with gold and precious stones and pearls, having in her hand a golden cup full of abominations and the filthiness of her fornication. And on her forehead a name was written:

MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND OF THE ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.

I saw the woman, drunk with the blood of the saints and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus. And when I saw her, I marveled with great amazement. But the angel said to me, "Why did you marvel? I will tell you the mystery of the woman and of the beast that carries her, which has the seven heads and the ten horns. The beast that you saw was, and is not, and will ascend out of the bottomless pit and go to perdition. And those who dwell on the earth will marvel, whose names are not written in the Book of Life from the foundation of the world, when they see the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.

Here is the mind which has wisdom: The seven heads are seven mountains on which the woman sits. There are also seven kings. Five have fallen, one is, and the other has not yet come. And when he comes, he must continue a short time. The beast that was, and is not, is himself also the eighth, and is

of the seven, and is going to perdition. "The ten horns which you saw are ten kings who have received no kingdom as yet, but they receive authority for one hour as kings with the beast. These are of one mind, and they will give their power and authority to the beast. These will make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them, for He is Lord of lords and King of kings; and those who are with Him are called, chosen, and faithful." Then he said to me, "The waters which you saw, where the harlot sits, are peoples, multitudes, nations, and tongues. And the ten horns which you saw on the beast, these will hate the harlot, make her desolate and naked, eat her flesh and burn her with fire. For God has put it into their hearts to fulfill His purpose, to be of one mind, and to give their kingdom to the beast, until the words of God are fulfilled. And the woman whom you saw is that great city which reigns over the kings of the earth."

3. The Jewish people will be allowed to rebuild the temple (3rd Temple) in Jerusalem.

Matthew 24:1 & 2- Then Jesus went out and departed from the temple, and His disciples came up to show Him the buildings of the temple. And Jesus said to them, "Do you not see all these things? Assuredly, I say to you, not one stone shall be left here upon another, that shall not be thrown down."

In these verses Jesus describes the destruction of the second temple, which occurred in 70 AD.

Matthew 24:15 & 16 - Therefore when you see the 'abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place' (whoever reads, let him understand), "then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains.

In these verses Jesus is talking about an event that will take place in the temple during the final days, or the great tribulation period. Since the 2nd temple was destroyed in 70 AD, this shows that the Temple will be rebuilt again.

4. After 3½ years the antichrist will desecrate the temple and this will bring on the 3½ years of the Tribulation.

Matthew 24:15 & 16 - Therefore when you see the 'abomination of desolation, spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place' (whoever reads, let him understand), "then let those who are in Judea flee to the mountains.

I am using these verses again because they talk to the desecration of the Temple and warns the people to flee, because the tribulation will begin after they witness this event taking place.

5. In chapters 19 & 20 of the book of Revelation it is revealed that Jesus will return with an Army, defeat Satan (19:11-21) and establish His kingdom on earth for 1000 years (20:4-6)

Revelation 19:11-21 - Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written:

KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

Then I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the birds that fly in the midst of heaven, "Come and gather together for the supper of the great God, that you may eat the flesh of kings, the flesh of captains, the flesh of mighty men, the flesh of horses and of those who sit on them, and the flesh of all people, free and slave, both small and great." And I saw the beast, the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against Him who sat on the horse and against His army. Then the beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image. These two were cast alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone. And the rest were killed with the sword which proceeded from the mouth of Him who sat on the horse. And all the birds were filled with their flesh.

Revelation 20:4-6 - And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. Then I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their hands. And they lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years. But the rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection. Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection. Over such the second death has no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years.

6. All who have not accepted Jesus as their Lord and Savior WILL spend eternity in hell:

Revelation 20:11-15 - Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away. And there was found no place for them. And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God, and books were opened. And another book was opened, which is the Book of Life. And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books. The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to his works. Then Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire.

7. The new heaven and the new earth will be established and Jesus will reign over all who are saved for eternity. This is found in Revelation 21 and 22. I suggest that you read these for yourself.

The following are the list of the judgements that will occur in the tribulation period. There are 3 sets of 7 judgements, the Seal Judgements, The Trumpet Judgements and the Bowl Judgements. If you read these you will see what God has planned for the end of this world.

Second Seal: Conflict on Earth

Third Seal: Scarcity on Earth

Fourth Seal: Widespread Death on Earth

Fifth Seal: The Cry of the Martyrs

Sixth Seal: The great day of The Lord's wrath

Seventh Seal: Prelude to the Seven Trumpets

Revelation Chapter 8, 9, 10 & 11

First Trumpet: Vegetation Struck

Second Trumpet: The Seas Struck

Third Trumpet: The Waters Struck

Fourth Trumpet: The Heavens Struck

Fifth Trumpet: The Locusts from the Bottomless Pit

Sixth Trumpet: The Angels from the Euphrates

Seventh Trumpet: The Kingdom Proclaimed

Revelation Chapter 16

First Bowl: Loathsome Sores

Second Bowl: The Sea Turns to Blood

Third Bowl: The Waters Turn to Blood

Fourth Bowl: Men Are Scorched

Fifth Bowl: Darkness and Pain

Sixth Bowl: Euphrates Dried Up

Seventh Bowl: The Earth Utterly Shaken

The Bible concludes with a warning:

Revelation 22:18-19

¹⁸ For I testify to everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: If anyone adds to these things, God will add to him the plagues that are written in this book; ¹⁹ and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part from the Book of Life, from the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.

And a promise “**I Am Coming Quickly**”

Revelation 22:20-21

²⁰ He who testifies to these things says, “**Surely I am coming quickly.**” Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus!

²¹ The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen.

If the Rapture has taken place and you are still on earth you have a choice to make. Accept Jesus as your Savior and Lord or denounce Him.

Either way the next 7 years will be filled with much tribulation that you cannot avoid. Your choice is about how you will spend eternity!

Eternal Life with God!

John 3:11- 21

¹¹ Most assuredly, I say to you, We speak what We know and testify what We have seen, and you do not receive Our witness. ¹² If I have told you earthly things and you do not believe, how will you believe if I tell you heavenly things? ¹³ No one has ascended to heaven but He who came down from heaven, that is, the Son of Man who is in heaven. ¹⁴ And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up, ¹⁵ that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. ¹⁶ For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. ¹⁷ For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved. ¹⁸ "He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. ¹⁹ And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. ²⁰ For everyone practicing evil hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed. ²¹ But he who does the truth comes to the light, that his deeds may be clearly seen, that they have been done in God."
